- ✓ Familiarity with the Christian Outreach College Preschool Handbook.
- ✓ Payment of a onetime enrolment fee to secure your child's place.  
(non refundable except in the case of exceeded class size)
- ✓ Completion of the Christian Outreach College Preschool Enrolment Form, Outdoor Playground Release Form and EYFS Information Form.
- ✓ One copy of your child's immunisation record and one copy of your child's passport or identity card must be given to the school for our records.
